To Whom It May Concern:

A subcommittee of Julie Almond (HealthFirst), Tracy Ibbotson (St Anne's Hospital), Dan Long (BayCoast Bank) and Melissa Terra (Person with lived experience and expertise) met on September 23, 2024, to review and rank the renewal projects that will be part of the Fall River CoC application this year.

After careful thought and consideration, the subcommittee formulated the ranking of the eight (8) programs for the CoC application that you will find below. In reaching this decision, the subcommittee took into consideration the importance of several factors: utilization of contract funds from prior years as well as review of programmatic performance measures. Please note that the performance indicator of percent of participants with zero income at entry was not factored due to all projects' performance on this being below the HUD minimum goal (80%).

The recommendation committee is grateful for the opportunity to be part of the review process and appreciative of the time that the representatives from all projects gave in meeting with us to explain their respective projects and answer all our questions.
